

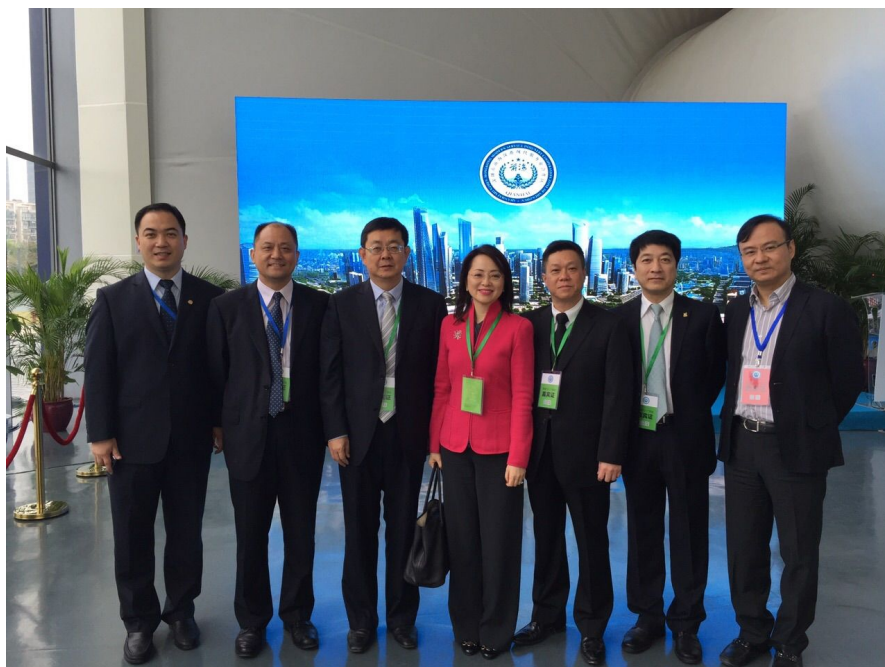
Qianhai Shenzhen-Hong Kong Modern Service Industry Cooperation Zone Visit
